Class 2 – Pedal assist with throttle option, 20 mph

Class 3 – Pedal assist, 28 mph

- Multi-use trails Class 1, 2 & 3 allowed.
- Single track trails ebikes prohibited.
- Sidewalks and pedestrian malls all bikes prohibited.

# **Snowmass Village**

- Paved trails Class 1 allowed.
- All Trails Class 2 & 3 prohibited.
- Non-paved trails ebikes prohibited.

### **Pitkin County**

- Paved trails Class 1 allowed.
- Non-paved trails ebikes prohibited.
- Single track trails ebikes prohibited.
- All Trails Class 2 & 3 prohibited.

### Rio Grande Trail – Aspen to Glenwood Springs

- Aspen to Stein Park Class 1 allowed.
- Stein Park to Emma schoolhouse Class 1 allowed.
- Emma schoolhouse to Glenwood Springs Class 1 & 2 currently allowed. Subject to change.
