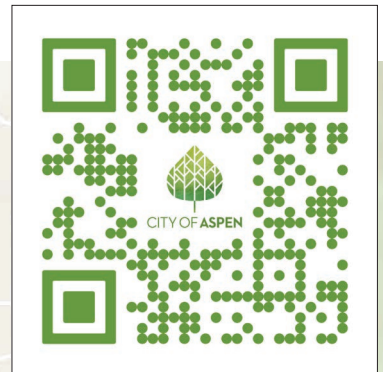
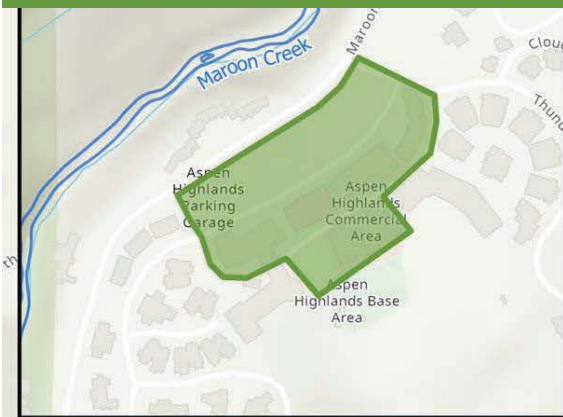

In addition, outside of the mask zone, masks are required in all public places indoors and outdoors if social distancing can't be maintained

Where should a face covering be worn?

- ✓ Indoors & outdoors in public spaces
Aspen's Mandatory Mask Zone
- ✓ Everywhere else outside of the Zone indoors & outdoors in public places when a 6' distance cannot be maintained from others
- ✓ On public transportation

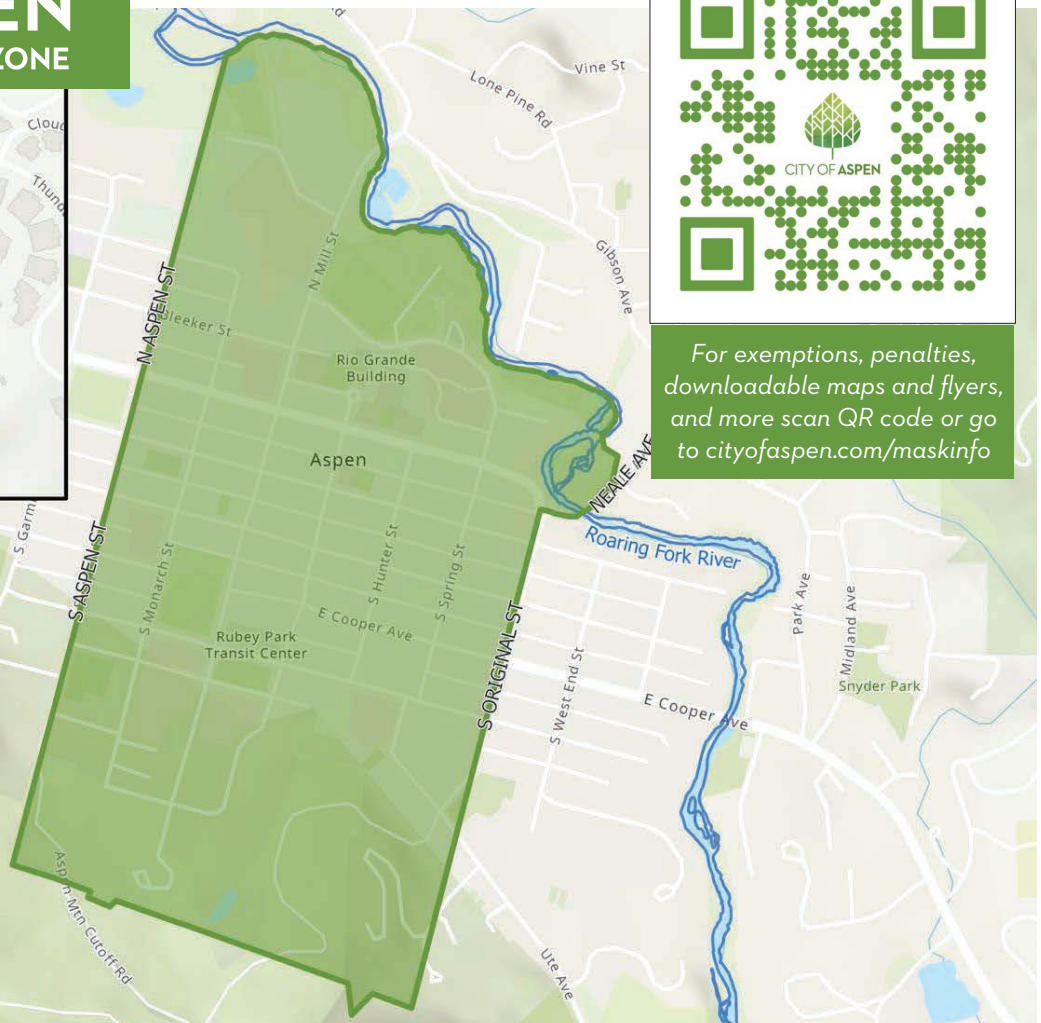
CITY OF ASPEN MANDATORY FACE COVERING ZONE

- South: Aspen Mountain
- North: Roaring Fork River
- Highlands transportation and commercial zone
