Congresswoman Boebert:

Congratulations on your recent swearing-in as our congressional representative. It is truly an honor you campaigned hard to earn and an exciting time to serve in federal office.

I am writing today as an individual member of the Aspen City Council to formally request that you provide the specific evidence upon which you intend to base your objection to the certification of electoral votes of states other than Colorado. As you know Colorado voted in the majority for Joe Biden to become our next president. If your objections were successful, you would be assisting in invalidating the vote of citizens of the State of Colorado.

As you now are formally seated as our representative, who's salary, offices and staff are paid for by the taxpayers whom you serve and represent, I am respectfully requesting a response from you prior to your actions in Congress on January 6th.
